Format: Single round robin of best-of-three matches.

Games played under WCF 2007 rules. All games start from corner four (yellow flag). Hoop setting will be 3 11/16 inches.

There will be no time limit on games but the Tournament Management may impose a limit of a further 10 minutes after a minimum of 50 minutes in any game.

On time expiry the current hoop is finished and the result then stands unless there is a tie in which case a further hoop is played.

Morning and afternoon teas available. Lunches available from nearby shops.

Players are requested to at the venue at least 15 minutes before play.
