

Croquetwest GC State Handicap Singles

Main Venue: Moorabinda

A secondary venue may be used depending on entries.

Entires: a maximum of 24 players (or pairs for doubles) may compete if four lawns are available, 18 if three lawns, and 12 if two lawns. These numbers 'overload' lawns by 50%, but are considered a reasonable compromise between the negative of sitting out and the positive of allowing greater number of competitors.

Notes:

* If entry numbers are greater than maximums detailed above, then, unless a solution can be engineered, priority is to be given to lowest handicap entries.

Format: Play will commence with seeded block play. The top 4 players will then proceed to a Knockout event held on the final day; with losers continuing to play in various blocks and play-offs.

The games will be conducted using the ADVANTAGE Model as trialled last year.

More information will provided at a later date as a review is currently under way to consider certain recommendations. A 19 point version will also be coming out next year.

Warm Ups: Courts open for practice from approximately 7.30 am each day. A three minute warmup will be also allowed for players who are playing on a new court for the first time each day and for players who have had a break between games of 30 minutes or more (their opponents will also be allowed this warmup).
